



General Conditions of Participation in Exhibition AUTOCOMPLEX (Autofilling Complex. Autoservice. Garage & Parking)

These General Conditions regulate the relationships between ACS-EXPO Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as ACS-EXPO) as the exhibition organizer and the Exhibitors (hereinafter referred to as the Exhibitor).

1. Registration of participation

1.1 The Exhibitor, wishing to take part in the exhibition, shall submit to ACS-EXPO an application according to the specified form. Such application shall be signed by a duly authorized person and certified with the Company's official stamp.

1.2 The date of assembly, work and disassembly, thematic sector, the deadline for submission of applications, rental payment and registration fee rates shall be determined in the relevant application documents submitted to ACS-EXPO.

1.3 Upon the application submission the Exhibitor shall accept these conditions without reserve. ACS-EXPO shall not accept the Exhibitor's counter conditions, with the exception of cases when they are approved by ACS-EXPO in writing.

1.4 After approval of all the conditions of participation, ACS-EXPO and the Exhibitor shall sign a contract for participation in the exhibition which must be signed by authorized persons. These General Conditions shall be a constituent part of the contract concluded.

1.5 Collective stand set up may be allowed at the exhibition subject to ACS-EXPO preliminary approval.

1.6 For the purposes of making prompt decisions with respect to the exhibition preparation and holding, ACS-EXPO and the Exhibitor shall have the right to execute the contract and exchange any other documents by fax communication and electronic mail with further mandatory dispatch of the originals of the specified documents.

1.7 ACS-EXPO shall reserve the right to deny registration.

In particular, this provision may be applied to, but not limited to the following events:

- if the exhibits presented by the Exhibitor do not correspond to the exhibition nomenclature;
- if the application submitted is not complete or contains errors and mistakes, or if the Exhibitor does not accept these Conditions of Participation in the exhibition;
- if the Exhibitor, intending to assemble its stand by its own efforts, has failed to represent the detailed technical plans of stands assembly for this purpose;
- if the Exhibitor failed to make complete payment for the services rendered during any previous exhibitions, or violated conditions of participation in exhibitions.

Any claims concerning admission to the exhibition shall be excluded.

1.8 ACS-EXPO shall have the exclusive right to provide exhibition premises in the exposition. Thus, the Exhibitor's requests shall be taken into account to the extent practicable.

2. Exhibition areas. Stand assembly

2.1 Exhibition areas shall be leased to the Exhibitor for the period of the exhibition assembly, work and disassembly in a state suitable for their use for the purposes specified.

Rental payment for exhibition premises shall also include the following: cost of general electric lighting, heating, ventilation of the indoor exhibition areas; cost of overall security of the exhibition territory; cost of cleaning of the overall territory of the exhibition, and passageways to the pavilions; cost of garbage collection from specially designated places during assembly, work and disassembly of the exhibition; cost of advertising at the exhibition; cost of insurance of the leased premises from fire, as well as liability insurance with respect to any damage caused to the exhibition visitors' health.

2.2 Exhibition areas shall be leased to the Exhibitor according to the contract for participation in the exhibition both not equipped and equipped (a turn-key stand).

A firm which has ordered an equipped exhibition territory shall be provided with standard equipment of such territory, including assembly and disassembly, as well as the services specified in the relevant application and/or contract for participation. The Exhibitor shall be liable for loss or damage of the equipment rented.

ACS-EXPO shall have the exclusive right to provide exhibition premises in the exposition.

2.3 The Exhibitor shall have the right to perform assembly of the stand individually by its own efforts. In this case the Exhibitor shall provide ACS-EXPO with a related package of technical documentation (a plan and technical specifications) not later than 30 calendar days prior to the beginning of the assembly.

The stands height shall not exceed 2.5 meters. The stands height may be exceeded only subject to ACS-EXPO approval. In case of a two-tier stand a 50% charge shall be added to the rental payment for the exhibition premises.

2.4 The Exhibitor shall follow the instructions of the fire engineering department and other persons responsible for maintenance of order and safety with respect to the stand structure, the exposition displayed and the advertisement placed within the stand. Representation (display) of any advertising material shall be allowed only within the stand.

2.5 Application of any audio equipment shall be allowed only in those cases when it does not disturb other exhibitors. ACS-EXPO shall have the right to set the maximum permissible sound volume of such equipment.

2.6 The Exhibitor's authorized representative shall be present at the place of the exposition within the whole period of the exhibition. The Exhibitor shall disclose the last name of the authorized representative prior to the beginning of assembly works.

2.7 Upon termination of the exhibition simultaneously with the beginning of its disassembly the Exhibitor shall return all rented equipment and inventory in operative condition, or pay its full value in case of any damage or loss.

2.8 No retail trade shall be allowed at stands.

2.9 ACS-EXPO shall reserve the right to prohibit any independent stand assembly, in case of delay of the required plans submission, or their inconsistency with the applicable technical specifications. In case of such refusal the Exhibitor shall have the right to submit a request for standard basic equipment assembly, and pay for it prior to the beginning of the general assembly. Otherwise the contract shall not be deemed

concluded.

Should the Exhibitor fail to appear at the stand 24 hours before the opening day of the exhibition, ACS-EXPO shall have the right to redistribute its space or use this space at its own discretion.

Henceforth the Exhibitor shall continue to fulfil its obligations under the contract, but shall not have the right to claim compensation for damages.

2.10 The Exhibitor shall be provided with access to its stand only during the official working hours of the exhibition assembly, work and disassembly.

Apart from these hours, access may be provided only subject to ACS-EXPO written authorization, and on condition of payment of the additional fee. For this purpose a preliminary written request shall be submitted.

3. Technical and supplementary services

3.1 The Exhibitor shall be in due time provided with the "Exhibitor's Manual" clarifying the conditions, as well as the details of execution of orders for different supplementary services.

3.2 Any supplementary technical services required, such as: electric power, water, and etc., may be ordered from ACS-EXPO exclusively by means of filling-in of a special form containing the relevant prices.

Independent provision of the Exhibitor's stand with the services specified shall be strictly prohibited, and shall be deemed the reason for termination of the contract on behalf of ACS-EXPO.

Should the Exhibitor violate the conditions specified it shall be liable to ACS-EXPO for any damages caused by such violation.

3.3 The Exhibitor may order from ACS-EXPO technical equipment for its stand, as well as additional passes to the exhibition for its employees and vehicles. For these purposes the Exhibitor shall fill in the relevant forms.

4. Registration fee

The Exhibitor shall pay a registration fee in the amount specified in the relative application documents.

Such registration fee shall include payment for entry of the information in the exhibition official catalogue, passes and exhibition invitation tickets, 2 copies of the catalogue.

5. Sub-exhibitor

Sub-exhibitors are the exhibitors present at the stand apart from the main participant of the exhibition. They shall accept the conditions of participation in the exhibition.

The relevant registration fee shall be paid for each sub-exhibitor. Information on each sub-exhibitor shall be entered into the exhibition official catalogue.

6. Collective stand

6.1 The collective exposition organizer and ACS-EXPO shall execute a separate contract for participation in the exhibition.

6.2 The collective stand organizer shall provide the list of companies-participants indicating the country of their registration, postal address, and the area of exhibition premises, not later than 90 days prior to the beginning of assembly works.

The collective stand organizer shall be held liable for observance of the General Conditions of participation by such companies-participants.

The collective stand organizer shall provide necessary information for the exhibition official catalogue with respect to all companies-participants, and itself, in case of renting an individual stand.

7. Exhibits

The relevant information on the goods/services exhibited shall be specified in the application.

Any highly explosive, highly inflammable exhibits, including those with a strong smell, as well as any exhibits, display of which causes intense noise, may be exhibited only subject to ACS-EXPO written approval.

Removal of any exhibits during the exhibition shall be prohibited.

Presentation and operation of any exhibits shall be performed within the leased premises.

ACS-EXPO shall not be liable for licence protection of the goods and services presented by the Exhibitor.

8. Payment conditions

8.1 Registration fee and rental payment for the leased premises shall be paid to the ACS-EXPO settlement account within the terms specified in the contract for participation in the exhibition.

8.2 Any supplementary services ordered by the Exhibitor shall be provided by ACS-EXPO subject to receipt of the monetary funds to its settlement account.

9. Official catalogue

"Exhibitor's Manual" provided to the Exhibitor after the contract conclusion shall contain the form for entering information into the official catalogue. The Exhibitor shall fill in and submit the form within the term specified. Should the Exhibitor fail to submit the form or violate the requirements specified therein, ACS-EXPO shall have the right to use the information specified in the application for the purposes of the Exhibitor's information entry into the catalogue. Entry into the catalogue shall include the Exhibitor's business name, and complete address, as well as information about the company, the text of which shall not exceed 75 words.

Should the Exhibitor intend to enter any additional information or advertising into the catalogue, it shall agree on such entry with ACS-EXPO and fill in the appropriate form. Any claims concerning inclusion of any additional information or advertising into the catalogue shall be excluded.

10. Exhibitor's liability. Withdrawal from participation

Should the Exhibitor violate the terms of rental payment and insurance payments, ACS-EXPO shall have the right to terminate the contract for participation in the exhibition unilaterally.

The contract for participation in the exhibition may be terminated in some other cases subject to any material violation of the provisions and requirements of the General Conditions of participation.

In such cases the contract shall be terminated by sending to the Exhibitor the appropriate written notification about termination of the contract.

The date of termination of contractual relations shall be the date specified in such notification.

At that, the monetary funds transferred by the Exhibitor shall be retained as compensation of the expenses incurred.

10.1 Should the Exhibitor reduce the leased exhibition premises or withdraw from participation in the exhibition after conclusion with ACS-EXPO of the contract for participation in the exhibition, the Exhibitor shall pay a penalty according to the following rates:

- in case of reduction of the area applied for – 50% of the rental payment for the area not used;
- in case of withdrawal from participation – 100% of the rental payment for the area applied for.

11. Working hours

Pavilions working hours during the exhibition assembly, work and disassembly shall be from 8.00 a.m. till 8.00 p.m.

Assembly and disassembly works exceeding the specified working hours may be allowed subject to ACS-EXPO approval.

Extension of pavilions working hours during the exhibition assembly, work and disassembly may be allowed pursuant to the Exhibitor's warranty letter, subject to extra payment, and shall be executed preliminarily, not later than 24 hours prior to them.

After its official opening the exhibition shall operate on a daily basis from 10.00 a.m. till 6.00 p.m. On the last day – till 4.00 p.m., unless otherwise is provided.

12. Security

During the period of the exhibition assembly, work and disassembly ACS-EXPO shall provide overall security of the exposition. At that, ACS-EXPO shall not be liable for safe keeping of separate exhibits.

The Exhibitor shall have the right to engage at its own expense some additional security from among the exhibition complex personnel.

13. Insurance

13.1 Rental payment for the exhibition premises shall include the cost of insurance of the leased premises from fire, as well as liability insurance with respect to any damage caused to the exhibition visitors' health.

13.2 Other types of insurance can be provided by the Exhibitor independently at its own expense.

Insurance contracts shall be deemed acceptable if they specify that the right of claim to ACS-EXPO shall not transfer, within the limit of the amount paid, to the insurer, who paid such indemnity.

13.3 ACS-EXPO shall be informed in written form without delay about the Exhibitor's damages connected with the exhibition.

14. Forwarding services. Customs clearance

Forwarding services of exhibitions held at the Central Exhibition Complex EXPOCENTR, customs clearance of exhibits and other exhibition equipment shall be provided by ExpoWesTrans – ACS-EXPO General Forwarding Agent.

ExpoWesTrans shall provide delivery and processing of cargo and packing, customs clearance of exhibits and other exhibition equipment of the Exhibitors, and shall render other services.

The Exhibitor shall have the right to engage other forwarding companies' services subject to agreement on all the details with ExpoWesTrans.

During the exhibition, the exhibition complex territory shall be temporarily considered the customs surveillance zone.

15. Assistance with visas registration

ACS-EXPO provides assistance with registration of entrance visas for the Exhibitors of the exhibition.

In case of necessity, any Exhibitor making use of ACS-EXPO services may register its residence at a private address.

16. Exhibition cancellation or postponement

16.1 In the event of change of the exhibition date, or in the event of its cancellation subject to any circumstances occurred through no fault of ACS-EXPO, the latter shall notify the Exhibitors about the fact in written form. Thus, the obligations of ACS-EXPO stipulated by the General Conditions of participation shall become invalid. ACS-EXPO shall have the right to retain the funds spent subject to the Exhibitor's instruction. The Exhibitor shall have no right to claim compensation for damages.

16.2 In the event of change of the exhibition date, or in the event of its cancellation through any fault of ACS-EXPO within the period of 3 months prior to its holding, and subject to immediate notification of the Exhibitors about the fact, ACS-EXPO shall be exempt from any liability to the Exhibitors.

16.3 Registration fee shall not be refunded in any event.

17. Disputes settlement

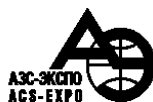
The current legislation of the Russian Federation shall be applied with respect to any contractual relations connected with the exhibition.

Any disputes and disagreements arising during fulfilment of the contract shall be settled by the Exhibitor and ACS-EXPO by means of negotiations. Should the Parties fail to settle the disputes by means of negotiations, such disputes, disagreements or claims arising out of or in connection with the contracts, with respect to fulfilment, violation, termination or invalidity of the contract, shall be referred for exclusive consideration to the International Commercial Arbitration Court at the Chamber of Commerce and Industry of the Russian Federation.

Any decisions of such court shall be final and binding for the Parties. Russian material law shall be applicable.

18. Final provisions

The Exhibitor undertakes to observe the applicable current laws. ACS-EXPO shall be exempt from any liability for any violation of the law by the Exhibitor. This provision shall be applied with respect to (but not limited to) trademarks protection, copyrights, hygienic regulations and fire safety rules, as well as customs legislation observance.
